Mission Statement: The Junior League of Bryan-College Station, Inc. is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving our community through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable.

I. **VOLUNTEER TIME CONTRIBUTION:** As a member, I commit to complete the required volunteer service points with League Activities: one (1) hour of time is approximately equal to one (1) point. My agreement serves as a commitment to fulfill my duties faithfully and to the best of my abilities as well as require me to assist in other duties as the need arises. The *Provisional Course Outline* and *Calendar* sets the course content and format and requires a minimum of 80 points dedicated to volunteering for The Junior League of Bryan-College Station, Inc. Included in the 80 points is 24 points that will be dedicated towards our two fundraising events: Charity Ball held on Saturday, December 12, 2020 and Bargain Blitz held on Friday, March 5 & Saturday, March 6, 2021. I understand that my Charity Ball duties may require me to work the day of and during the event. Likewise, I understand that I am obligated to work the weekend of Bargain Blitz.

II. **FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION:**

Dues: A one-time (non-refundable) provisional course fee of \$45.00 as well as the annual Membership dues of \$120.00 is to be paid by Saturday, May 31, 2020 for a total of \$165.00. Friday, July 31, 2020 is the deadline to be eligible for a refund of dues in the event of resignation. These dues can be paid in installments if needed. **Fees are subject to change with approval from the Board of Directors.**

Charity Ball: All active and provisional members have a \$150.00 Charity Ball contribution requirement. Examples of meeting the commitment are as follows*:

- Purchase a reservation to Charity Ball
- Sell a Charity Ball reservation to another individual, excluding Junior League members and their spouses
- Purchase a Junior League sponsorship
- Solicit and return a signed contract for sponsorship in coordination with Sponsor Relations**
- Donate an auction item with a minimum market value of \$250 (will be subject to the approval of the Fund Development VP)
- Sell a minimum number of raffle tickets (minimum to be determined by the Fund Development VP)

*Subject to change upon approval of Board.

**Except members of the Sponsor Relations Committee.

Bargain Blitz: All active and provisional members have a \$75.00 Bargain Blitz contribution requirement. Tenured active members have no contribution requirement. Active and provisional members shall donate \$75 of gently used, sellable goods (there will be a limit on the dollar amount of clothing allowed to count towards the \$75 which will be posted at a later date). Other arrangements are to be approved by the Board of Directors.

III. **ATTENDANCE:** Attendance is required at monthly provisional meetings and general membership meetings.

IV. **BY-LAWS AND STANDING RULES:** In addition to the obligations set forth in this agreement, I am bound by and subject to the *Bylaws and Standing Rules* of The Junior League of Bryan-College Station, Inc.

V. **VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** I will not seek or accept any payment (except reimbursement for direct expenses) for any service performed as a member of The Junior League of Bryan-College Station, Inc.

Social Media Policy

The Junior League of Bryan-College Station, Inc. (JLBCS) members are encouraged to participate in social media as a way to enhance the important work of JLBCS. The purpose of these guidelines is to ensure all members are aware of potential issues and strive to represent JLBCS professionally. League members shall adhere to the following guidelines for social media posts, tags, tweets, pictures, videos or any other form of social media communication that represents the League (JLBCS events, meetings, wearing JLBCS attire, etc.):

I, _____ understand that I will be held to the following JLBCS Social Media Policy.

- Represent JLBCS positively - Protect the reputation of JLBCS through my comments and actions. Post items that would positively reflect JLBCS to our members, community, or donors. Refrain from posting inappropriate photos (i.e. consuming alcohol, inappropriate dress or body language) while at League events; representing League at an event or while wearing attire with the league logo.
- Privacy - Confidential information should never be shared via any social media, especially League related confidential information. Consider seeking the permission of all members in a picture before posting.
- Sharing Information - When in a public setting, respectfully voice ideas and opinions. League members must be aware that opinions they express may damage the League's reputation as a source of information. Members should strive to be diplomatic when declaring their views on contentious issues in any public forum. Information shared should always be respectful.
- Internet History and Privacy - Oftentimes, content posted to the internet is permanent and cannot be deleted. Content and comments posted on the internet can be traced to the original source. You are always accountable for what you post. We recommend customizing privacy settings to determine what you share with whom to always keep confidential information confidential.
- Positive Messages - Share information that reflects positively on JLBCS and myself as a member of our league and community. Refrain from negativity.
- Donors - Members should be aware that all businesses are active or potential donors and supporters of JLBCS. As such, members should refrain from posting negative comments about businesses via social media.
- Think globally, act locally - My local posts can have global significance. Local comments can be linked and shared to the larger Association of Junior League International community.

- JLBCS Social Media Pages - JLBCS members are responsible for sending information to the PR chair for publication on social media outlets. Anything published on official JLBCS pages must receive approval from the PR chair. Unauthorized League members should refrain from posting on the official JLBCS pages.
